### Notification: The Corporate Examination, 2024

The Corporate Educational Agency, Diocese of Mananthavady, is about to begin the selection process of teachers to fill the vacancies of LPST and UPST in its government-aided schools in the coming academic years. The selection process includes Three steps: the written test (TCE-2024), followed by an interview, and the merit part. The details of each step with corresponding marks are mentioned below:
