Notification: The Corporate Examination - 2026

The Corporate Educational Agency, Diocese of Mananthavady, formally announces the commencement of the teacher selection process to fill upcoming vacancies for Lower Primary School Teachers (LPST) and Upper Primary School Teachers (UPST) across its network of Government-Aided Schools for the upcoming academic years. To ensure a transparent and comprehensive evaluation, the recruitment framework is structured into three sequential phases comprising a written examination - The Corporate Examination - 2026 (TCE - 2026), an interview phase, and a merit-based qualification assessment.
